On Tuesday, our school captains and prefects will be travelling to Wagga to the GRIP Leadership Conference. This conference focuses on training student leaders for their role as SCHOOL LEADERS. The style, topics, and content of this conference all focus on what the students can do RIGHT NOW. Leaders will be traveling on a bus with West Wyalong Public School's leaders.

## High School Leaders Visit 5/6 Students

On Thursday morning, the leaders from West Wyalong High School will be visiting the 5/6 classroom. This will provide our students with an opportunity to listen to what happens at high school as well as ask the leaders questions about high school.

Our Year 6 will be having their first transition day, on Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> May, to the high school. Further information will be sent to the Year 6 students.

## Spelling using Orthographic Knowledge

Some of our students are sent home high frequency words that have been 'mapped' using orthographic knowledge, common letter patterns and rules. As a student builds orthographic knowledge, they become aware of the letter combinations that can be used in different words. These high frequency words are mapped with dots, dash, triangles and quad bikes which represent the number of letters for each sound. A dot = 1 letter for a sound (such as 'a', 's')  
A dash = 2 letters for a sound (such as 'ch', 'ee') – also known as a digraph.

A triangle = 3 letters for a sound (such as 'tch', 'are') – also known as a trigraph.

A quad bike = 4 letters for a sound (such as 'eight' in eight) – also known as a quadgraph.

It would be appreciated if you support your child by getting them to read the words and then spelling them. If they have trouble spelling them, they are encouraged to sound the words out and map them.

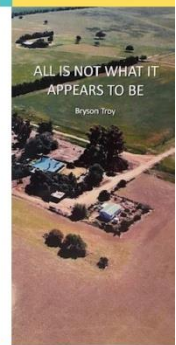
