Players are to arrive 15 minutes before to register and inform of 2 preferred playing positions. Be dressed in appropriate training gear.

There will be two stages in choosing the final team. The first is on Monday 26/11 followed by compulsory training at the courts on two dates to be announced in early February.

Commitment to Rep netball involves compulsory training once or twice a week (coaches decision) commencing February, playing in carnivals (on Sundays) and for some teams playing in the local Monday night competition. 12's, 13's, 14's and 15's will be playing in the State Age Championships in July. This involves a 4 day weekend. The 17's play in the State Championships over the long weekend in June.
