## TERM 4 WEST WYALONG JUNIOR TENNIS COMPETITION

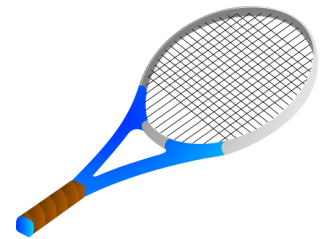
- Jay Taylor is organising a West Wyalong Junior Tennis Comp for students in Year 3 to Year 9

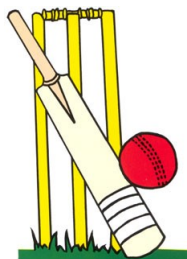
