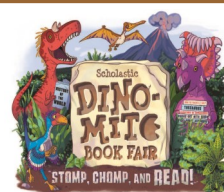
Memorabilia for our new time capsule


