## **Whole School Morning Routine**

The whole school participates in a morning movement routine which is aimed at creating a calm, focused atmosphere where students feel welcome, part of the Toppo team and are ready to learn.

The programme provides students with skills that can be utilised throughout their life.

The routine involves exercises, a check-in process and mindfulness activities.

\* The exercises focus on core stability, balance and strength using the student's own body weight.

\*The check-in activities turn on student's brain getting them ready to learn whilst also contributing to their sense of belonging, helping them to build trust and relationships.

\*The mindfulness activities involve relaxation, breathing and calming techniques. Evidence suggests these help to reduce anxiety and stress.

The student's enjoy the positive start to the day and staff have noticed an increase in their ability to self regulate and engage in their learning.




