The Vacation Care service is a licensed and fully supervised service where children must be signed in and out by a parent/guardian. Your child is welcome to attend for a part day but must be enrolled in the service prior to attending and full fees will apply.

A minimum number of 10 booked children required to conduct these sessions.
