It was exciting to welcome 15 new kindergarten orientation students and their family last Friday. All the students settled in and enjoyed learning about school routines and exploring the school grounds, especially the playground.

Reading for Stamina

Students have been working on increasing their reading stamina. This is the child's ability to read independently for longer periods of time. Students in 2-6 have been working on this together, reading for a littler longer each day, helping build stronger readers!

Currently, students are reading for 15 minutes every day.

If students read for 5 minutes a day they are exposed to 282 000 words a year but if they read for 15 minutes they will be exposed to **895 100** words. Reading for longer helps students increase their vocabulary, ability to access a variety of books and develop reading skills.

You can help at home by encouraging your child to read for 10 minutes each day.
