This term, students and staff will be participating in NSW Premier's Sporting Challenge. To promote increased participation in sport and physical activity leading to a healthier more active lifestyle the Premier Sporting Challenge records and tracks the physical activity over 10 weeks. Students and staff will be aiming to be more active more often.

Space Facts

Our students have been engaged in our English and science unit, Space. Over the last two weeks they have been learning interesting facts. Some of these include:

- Venus is the hottest planet because it has a thick, toxic atmosphere that traps and reflects the heat.
- Venus rotates backwards compared to Earth meaning that the sun rises in the west and sets in the east.
- Satellites are any object that orbits a planet or sun. There are over 200 known natural satellites in our solar system including all the planets and the moons.
- Artificial satellites are used to protect endangered species by providing clear images of migration that scientists use to help protect threatened animals from drought, habitat loss and poachers.
- The end of our solar system is 143.73 billion km from the Sun.

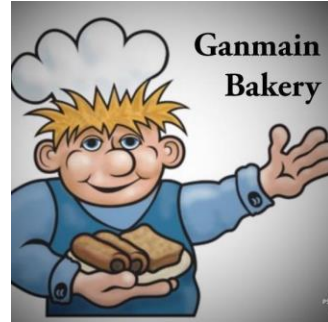

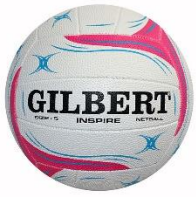

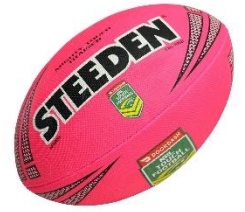

Applications for Year 5 opportunity class placement in 2023

Opportunity classes cater for intellectually gifted and high potential students who may otherwise be without sufficient classmates at their own academic and social level.

A Year 5 virtual opportunity class at Aurora College is available for students in rural and remote NSW. Students successfully placed at Aurora College attend their local public school and join the opportunity class for science, technology and mathematics lessons using an online conferencing system.

Students who wish to be considered for opportunity class placement will sit the Opportunity Class Placement Test on Thursday 28 July 2022.

If you would like to have your child considered for Year 5 opportunity class entry in 2023, you need to apply between **Tuesday 26 April 2022 and Friday 13 May 2022**. You will need to access the online application at:

You must not use the child's email address. When selecting your choices, select 'Aurora College' and enter your host school (current school for public school students). Late applications are not usually accepted.
