### **Education Week**

Last week we had a very busy week celebrating Education Week. On Thursday, we had 33 preschool students visit us and they all had a wonderful time playing at Big School.

On Friday, we welcomed back past student, Felicity Stanley who captured the attention of all our students. She addressed our assembly and spoke about never giving up and following your dreams and things you are passionate about. Felicity ran workshops with the students who dressed as scientists. She brought skulls that the students had to investigate and hypothesise what animal it belonged to by looking at the size, teeth and eye sockets. Did you know that carnivore animal's eyes are in the front so they can see prey, whereas a herbivore's eyes are on the side so they can see their predators?

In her university lab, they make 3D wound models that the training nurses use to practice their bandaging skills. The students were given the opportunity to provide first aid using these models on their peers.

Thank you to the P&C for supplying us with a BBQ lunch and also to Sal Crowe for cooking all the sausages. It was a fantastic day to end Education Week!

### All Systems Go – Life Education Incursion

Tomorrow our students will be participating in a virtual Life Education incursion. 'All Systems Go' focuses on the human body; it's uniqueness and what is needed to keep it healthy. This session will help your child understand why maintaining a healthy body and brain is the key to leading an active and productive life and gives them the tools to make sure they stay healthy. Students will discuss issues and engage in activities centred on:

- the impact food choices have on health and energy levels;
- the effects of second-hand smoking;
- exploring ways to manage peer pressure; and
- the function of vital organs including heart, lungs, brain and kidneys.
