



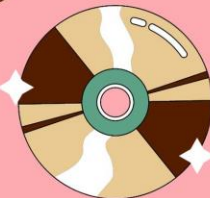

Points to be looked for in judging: Fine soft even texture, even golden brown on top sides & bottom. Top should be flat or slightly domed without peaking or cracking.
