The Intereach Early Childhood program can assist with Early Connections, of providing information about local mainstream services, early intervention supports and where eligible, in requesting access to the NDIS.

My child already has NDIS: What assistance/advice can Intereach provide? Advice on how to use your NDIS therapy hours, you may be feeling overwhelmed and not sure what to do now that you have the plan, understanding your child's personalised plan and unpacking its contents. Your child's plan review may be coming up and you may like guidance on this process.
