Senior Early Childhood Practitioners / Educators representing Intereach Limited National Disability Insurance Agency – Early Childhood Partner are attending West Wyalong at Bland Preschool

- Have you or your family heard about or have been recommended to look at accessing the NDIS?
- Does your child currently see two or more early intervention services? (Psychologist, Occupational Therapist, Speech Pathologist, Physio)
- Is your child eligible for NDIS?
- Does your child already have NDIS but you are overwhelmed and/or don't know WHERE TO NEXT?

If you answered 'yes' to any of the above questions then please make a booking below before FRIDAY, 2nd JUNE

Did you know: The Early Childhood Approach, supported by Intereach, can help your understanding of early intervention supports for a child with a developmental delay or a disability. The Intereach Early Childhood program can assist with Early Connections, of providing information about local mainstream services, early intervention supports and where eligible, in requesting access to the NDIS.

My child already has NDIS: What assistance/advice can Intereach provide? Advice on how to use your NDIS therapy hours, you may be feeling overwhelmed and not sure what to do now that you have the plan, understanding your child's personalised plan and unpacking its contents. Your child's plan review may be coming up and you may like guidance on this process.
