# WHATS HAPPENING IN THE YEAR 2 CLASS

Every morning during literacy, year 2 run through a daily review.

This revises phonic sounds and their alternative spellings, prefix's, suffix's, heart words as well as grammar, punctuation and spelling rules.

This week we revised action verbs, saying verbs, thinking verbs and relating verbs.

As well as split digraphs, heart words, oa, ee, u sounds and their spelling alternatives.

We also focused on the prefix un- meaning – not - the opposite of, contractions and a spelling rule.

During maths we played 10 or bust and 101 you're out, which is a game involving place value.

In Science, year 2 have grown sprouts and were amazed at the extensive root system of such a small plant.





































This term the P&C have introduced Sentral. Parents are able to purchase from the uniform store and order their lunch for canteen all through the app.


### WE ARE NOW LIVE!!


